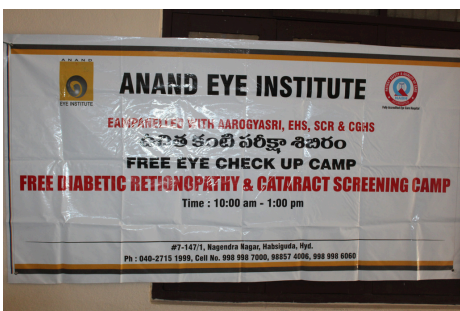


HEALTH CLUB

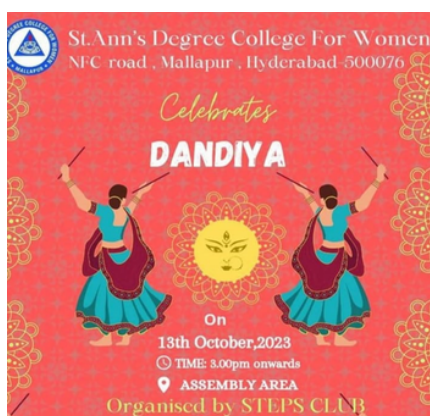


STEPS CLUB

This year UG students were taken to IKEA, Vijaya Dairy, and Picnic to Wild Waters and Wonderla.

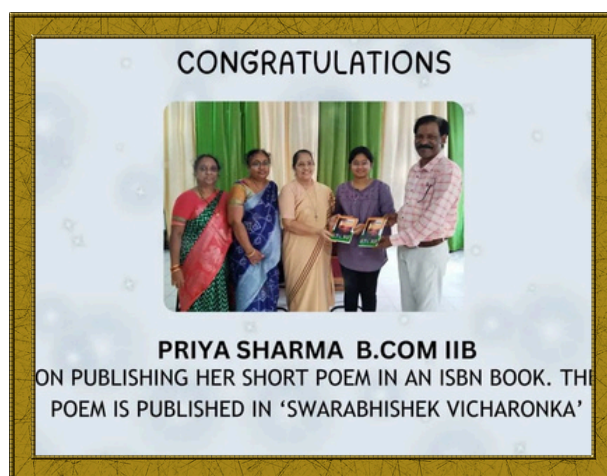

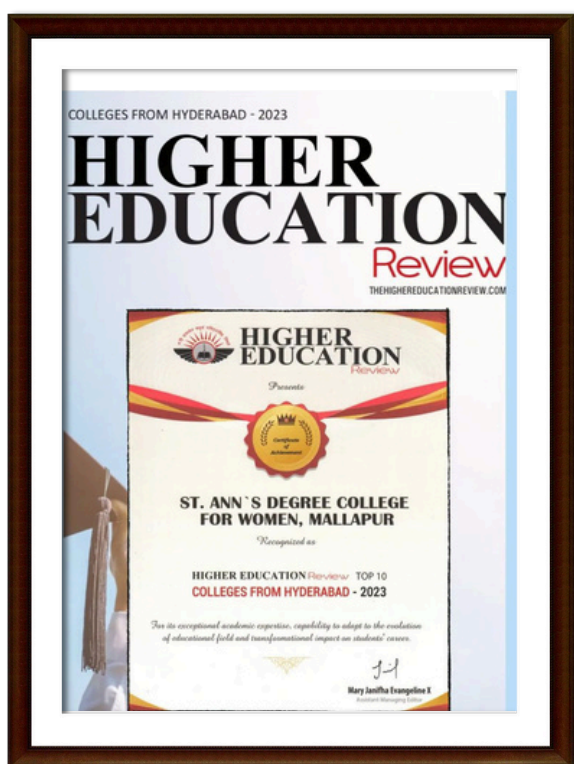
